TAX RULING - Dues payments to the Home Builders Association of Greater Terre Haute are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes. However, dues payments may be deductible as an ordinary and necessary business expense, subject to exclusion for lobbying activity. Because a portion of your dues is used for lobbying by NAHB and IBA, \$51.37 is not deductible for income tax purposes.
